**Blocks:** During our four, hour long blocks throughout the day, students will participate with their age based group in different activities and crafts centered around the daily theme. During this time, students will be in different locations of the school participating in specific theme based activities. These activities range from active sports in the gym, artistic crafts and science experiments in the cafeteria, team building and games in the LGI, and relays and competition outside! There is no limit to the options during these blocks!

**Let's Get Active:** Our main goal during this time is to have students stay actively engaged in an activity with the help of their HG teachers. We will have different options for the students to choose from throughout this hour on Monday, Wednesdays and Fridays that best suits their age and interest. Some examples of these activities may be yoga, jumping rope, kickball, basketball, and soccer with Mr. Dustin, walking and running with Mr. James on his famous free runs, and much more! We will also try to get outside as much as we can during this time! Let's ring in the spring by getting active!

**Discussion Groups:** On Tuesday and Thursdays, students will participate in a 15-20-minute group conversation of choice.
